1. Scola Air Drying Modelling Clay

Currently the college does not have a kiln. However, to re-introduce and deliver ceramics into the curriculum the art department wanted to purchase air drying clay to give as many students as possible the opportunity to work with this material and to experience ceramics as an extra curricular project.

2. Guitars

Five small guitars have been bought for students taking part in peripatetic instrument lessons in KS3, learning how to play the guitar.
