We are proud to provide an exceptional level of pastoral care and an ambitious curriculum, designed to develop a love of learning and intellectual curiosity.

Students also benefit from our excellent sporting facilities including a 25m swimming pool, a dojo for martial arts and a fitness suite.

Q What is a typical day at Ernest Bevin?

A The school day runs from 8.40am – 3.10pm. We have a 5 period day (each period lasts 1 hour). The school day has a 20 minute morning break and a 40 minute lunch break.

Q Are there any Extra-Curricular Activities?

A All students are expected to take part in at least one of the many extra-curricular activities on offer. There are a wide range of social, academic and sporting activities before school, at lunchtimes and after school.

Clubs change each year and this summer they include chess, cricket, football, debating, DT, judo, drama, STEM activities, swimming, table tennis and many others.

We are also one of three London schools to offer the Royal Marines Combined Cadet Force (CCF) from Year 9.

Q What if my child has an Educational and Health Care Plan?

A We work with the local authority to ensure we accommodate boys with additional needs. Inclusion is a core value at EBA. Our SENDCO will liaise with the SENDCO at your son's current school to ensure we fully understand their individual needs. They will put a support plan in place to enable your child to access a full and varied curriculum.

Q How do I accept a place at EBA?

A To secure your son's place, you will need to accept the offer via the EAdmissions website or by returning the forms, if you received your offer in the post. This must be done by the **16th March**.

Q What happens next?

A Once you have accepted the place there will be plenty of opportunities for you and your son to visit us to help ensure your son feels confident before he starts in September. You will be invited into school the week beginning 22nd June for an informal admissions meeting with a member of staff. On 1st July there is a borough-wide Induction Day where all pupils will spend the day at their new secondary school, getting to meet their new peers and staff. If your son would benefit from a one-to-one tour during a working school day, just let us know so we can arrange.
