Dear Parent/Carer

We are writing to inform you that Year 12 students will complete their mock examinations between Monday 8th June and Friday 12th June.

Why are these mock examinations important?

These mock examinations are a crucial milestone in your child's academic journey. The outcomes will:

- Provide important evidence of your child's current progress
- Inform discussions about future pathways, including university and employment destinations
- Contribute to references and predicted grades used in the UCAS application process
- Help identify any concerns regarding progress and suitability for progression into Year 13

As such, these exams should be approached with the same seriousness and preparation as final assessments. Please find the examination timetable attached.

Expectations During the Assessment Period

To ensure success, we ask that all students:

- Arrive at school no later than 8:30am each day.
- Attend for the full school day, including when not in an exam
- Avoid scheduling appointments during this period
- Understand that absence from an exam may result in a mark of zero

When students are not in an exam, they will attend their normal lessons or study periods.

Equipment Requirements

- Students must bring the correct equipment to every exam:
- A clear pencil case including:
- At least two black pens
- Pencil, eraser, sharpener, ruler, protractor
- Scientific calculator (if required)
- A clear water bottle containing water only (no labels)



Exam Regulations

All students must follow strict examination rules. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification. Students must:

- Begin only when instructed
- Hand in or switch off all devices (including phones and watches) before entering the exam
- Follow all staff instructions at all times
- Not communicate with other students during the exam
- Remain in the exam hall for the full duration unless directed otherwise

We strongly advise that students do not bring phones or watches on exam days.

How You Can Support Your Child

You can support your child's preparation by encouraging effective revision habits:

- Use a range of materials: notes, textbooks, revision guides, flashcards, and online platforms (e.g. UpLearn)

Plan balanced revision:

- 5–6 hours per day during holidays is typically effective
- Focus on the 3 Rs: Revise, Reward, Recharge

Minimise distractions:

- Keep mobile phones out of the revision space
- Use laptops/PCs for online work where needed

Use effective techniques:

- Retrieval practice (e.g. look–cover–write–check)
- Regular testing of knowledge
- Practice papers closer to exam time

After focused revision, short breaks and rewards help maintain motivation and concentration.

Please take the time to discuss these expectations with your child. We recognise that this is a demanding period, and we are committed to supporting students throughout. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Thank you for your continued support. We wish all Year 12 students the very best in their upcoming examinations and look forward to celebrating their achievements.
