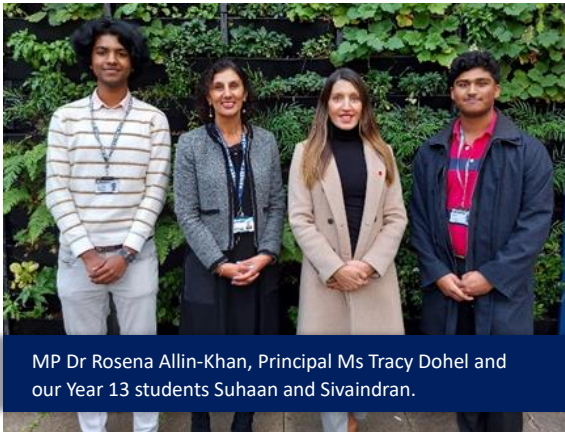
We hope you all enjoyed a wonderfully restful half-term break and had the chance to recharge.
